Driving questions we hope to address include

- how do we remain faithful to the church's vision and understanding of the eucharist when resources, both human and material, are stretched, and
- what does it mean, both theologically and practically, to sustain a eucharistic community in these varied contexts?

Rev'd Dr Alison Millbank, and others.

Based at a hall of residence on the University of Nottingham campus, to help us to engage with the different contexts, we will visit

- Nottingham city centre churches,
- Southwell Minster, our cathedral church based in a market town, and
- Our Lady of Egmont, one parish in a rural multi-parish benefice in the north of Nottinghamshire, a church with a medieval shrine to Our Lady which has found renewed use in modern times -- see, e.g. <http://www.sole-egmanton.com>

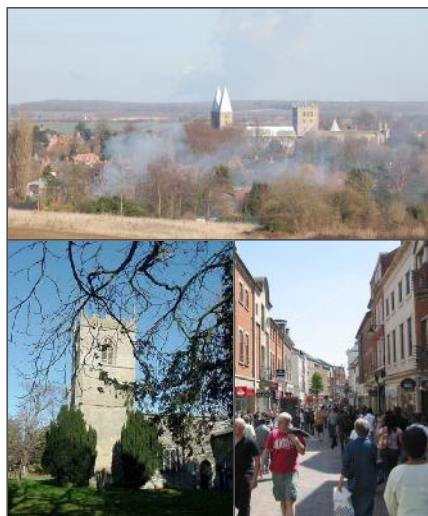
